Fabio embraced the values of AIESEC right from the start of his involvement with the organization as a student in the early 1980s. His charisma and leadership potential resulted in him being selected for a local committee president in 1980 and as a national committee president two years later. During his term as president, Fabio led one of the largest youth conventions in Colombia in the 1980s, dedicated on "Energy as a factor in the global economy". Fabio contributed to

the extension of AIESEC to Panama and supported the development of AIESEC in Puerto Rico, for which he is recognized as an honorary member of AIESEC in Puerto Rico.

Today Fabio continues his contribution to AIESEC, being the Chairman of the Supervisory Board of AIESEC in Colombia and
